What value have you seen in your MPI membership? MPI offers industry trends with cutting edge education for personal and professional growth. When we learn together, we instill trust within our meeting's community. I find great value in the networking events by having fun which deepens relationships authentically.

I hear that you have an interest in wellness, what advice do you have for our members who may be overwhelmed? When we become overwhelmed, our body initiates a stress response. This "fight or flight" response is driven by release of hormones (adrenaline & cortisol) Sometips I recommend as a certified wellbeing counselor is set yourself up for success.

- o Did you know that **sleep** is critical to flush out toxins in the brain & releases growth hormones. So, get a good night's sleep.
- o Food is Medicine. What we eat and drink play a significant role in influencing hormones and stress levels. The food we eat affects our body's hormonal balance which leads to stress. Good Nutrition turns on the good genes and turns off the bad genes. Magnesium helps regulate the cortisol stress hormone. So, eat your leafy greens from your Farmacy, nuts and dark chocolate
- Movement Matters as it releases endorphins which are neurotransmitters in the brain that promote feelings of happiness and euphoria. These feel-good chemicals act as natural stress relievers.
- When we spend a few minutes in breath work, we activate the parasympathetic nervous system which promotes a state of
 calmness. Breathing exercises reduces cortisol levels (stress hormone). Deep breathing increases oxygen intake which improves brain function.
- Meditation calms the mind, reduces stress hormones, enhances focus and increases self-awareness. You won't be alone meditating, your neighbor Marc Benifoff, CEO of Sales Force is always talking about the importance of mindfulness.

In summary, if you can make micro steps with the above insight into a daily practice, you will reduce stress and how you react to stress when you are overwhelmed and live life with more vitality.

Where do you live?


I just bought my first house in Lincoln!

Links Club


